Waste firm under fire in Kendall court

YORKVILLE — A landscape waste operation here will be spending a lot of time at the Kendall County Courthouse this month.

The operation on Route 71 west of West Highpoint Road, known as Fox Moraine LLC or Hamman Farms LLC, will face charges from both the Illinois attorney general's office and

the city of Yorkville.

On Wednesday, Hamman Farms will be in Kendall County Court for a status update on allegations from the attorney general's office of improper open dumping and violating its license to apply landscape waste by exceeding its 20-ton limit. The charges were filed in 2008 and amended in 2009.

On both May 19 and May 26, Fox Moraine, on the same property as Hamman

Farms, will answer to a total of five citations from Yorkville alleging "excessive litter on (its) farm field."

Those citations were issued several weeks ago by the city after complaints from residents who live near the property along Route 71.

Bart Olson, Yorkville's city administrator, said while Fox Moraine is licensed to accept landscape waste, it is supposed to pick through that waste when

brought to the property and separate garbage that might have wrongly been put into it.

He said if they don't do that, the trash surfaces when the landscape waste is applied to the farmland.

The attorney general's office also is looking at a complaint filed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency in April that the land application facility improperly burned corn stubble at the property.
